



HOW TO ACCESS HOOPLA

What is Hoopla?

Hoopla is now available through the Middlesex Public Library. Use your library card to access movies, music, ebooks, audiobooks, comics, and more!

Items can be viewed on your computer or via the Hoopla app on mobile devices like Kindle, iPad, iPhone, and Android. Users have simultaneous access to the content, so you never have to wait for someone else to return it before you can view.

You can borrow up to five items each month.

How to Use Hoopla

1. Click on the Hoopla logo on the library's website under eContent OR go directly to <https://www.hoopladigital.com/login>
2. Click the blue "Sign Up Now" button at the bottom of the page.
3. Choose the blue button that says "Middlesex Public Library." *NOTE: there are multiple Libraries named "Middlesex Public Library". We are the one that is JUST listed as "Middlesex Public Library."
4. Type the information into the appropriate boxes. You will need to give an email address and create a password (at least 8 characters). You will also need to give your library card number.
5. Click the blue button that says "Sign Up Now."
6. Click the blue button that says "Browse Titles."
7. Now you can browse the collection! You can also look for something specific using the search box at the top of the page.
