

How to Download eBooks to an iPad, Tablet, Smartphone, or Other Mobile Device

To download library ebooks to these devices, you will need to install an app. Amazon Kindle and the Kindle App will use the instructions for Kindle below, almost all other platforms (Nook, Sony Kobo, etc.) are supported by OverDrive.

To download ebooks using the Kindle App:

1. Go to the store your device uses (App Store, Android Market, etc.) and download the Kindle App.
2. Open the app.
3. You will need an Amazon account. If you have one already, register your device by entering the email address and password associated with your Amazon account. If you don't have an Amazon account, go to Amazon.com to create one, then return to the Kindle app to register with your new Amazon account.
4. Follow the directions "How to Download eBooks to a Kindle"

To download ebooks using OverDrive:

1. Go to the store your device uses (App Store, Android Market, etc.) and download the OverDrive Media Console App.
2. Open the app.
3. You will need an Adobe account. If you have one already, sign in. If you don't have one, register at Adobe.com, then return to the OverDrive app and sign in.
4. Once you are signed in, tap on "Get Books +" in the top right corner of the screen.

5. Tap on "Add a Library". Search for our library. It is easiest to search by ZIP code (08846).
6. Select Middlesex Public Library.
7. Tap on the star next to Infolink--ListenNJ, making it yellow, to make the app remember it as your library.
8. Then tap Infolink--ListenNJ. You will be taken to the eLibraryNJ website.
9. Follow the directions for "How to Download eBooks to a Nook, Sony eReader or Kobo
